Autumn Song with **Joseph Martin** is made up of individuals from multiple locations around the United States; therefore, transportation to/from Boston is not included in the tour cost. Some are planning to drive to Boston and others will be flying. The tour group will be assembled at the Boston Logan Airport. For Perform America to arrange your ground transportation to and from the Boston airport, you will need to follow these instructions carefully, otherwise you may be responsible for your airport transfers in Boston.

Due to the uncertainty of travel, please be sure that flights you book are either refundable or that the airline will waive change fees.

Meet your Tour Manager, Cathy Scheid, in Terminal B at 10:30 AM near the information desk on Level 1 Arrivals. (The meeting Terminal may change once all flight itineraries are received. Watch for updates closer to departure.)

We recommend that you first send an email asking for a quote. When you are ready to book your flight, you may call AFC at **952-886-7676 or 800-599-2925**. You will need your passport number, expiration date, or REAL ID Driver's license, birth date, and credit card to book your flight.

- Identify yourself as a traveler on the **Autumn Song** tour.
- You will book your flights as "round-trip" to and from Boston Logan Airport (BOS).
- Select flights with arrivals in Boston Logan (BOS) on September 28, 2021 between 8:00 AM and 10:00 AM and departure from Boston Logan (BOS) on Oct 4, 2021 between 8:00 AM-11:00 AM. People arriving and departing outside of these times may be responsible for their own airport transfers in Boston.
- Be prepared with your credit card information in order to finalize your airfare.
- Forward the flight confirmation you receive with your scheduled flight itinerary to kmontgomery@perform-international.com, so we can best coordinate your arrival/departure.

- Use popular travel websites such as [Travelocity](#), [Orbitz](#) and [Expedia](#).
- Contact a local travel agency.

Luggage Guidelines:

Here are luggage guidelines set by Perform America for your journey.

Checked Items or your Larger Suitcase

- You are allowed **ONE CHECKED PIECE or ONE LARGER SUITCASE** (Airlines allow more, but due to restricted luggage space on the motor coaches, we can only allow one checked bag).
- Please limit your checked or larger bag to a medium-sized suitcase, which is a maximum of 54 linear inches (length + width + height = linear inches). ***If flying, please plan to weigh your bags and anticipate paying any overage amount for poundage above and beyond the limit. Checked bags should weigh less than 50 pounds to avoid an extra charge by your airline. Should they weigh more than 50 pounds, you are responsible for the excess baggage fees charged by the airline.***
- VERY IMPORTANT: If traveling by air, during your check-in process, be sure that the airline tags your bag all the way through to Boston. The tag on your bag will read **BOS**.

Carry-on Items or your Small Bag

- You are allowed to one carry-on bag on your flight or one smaller bag, if you are driving, and one personal item (purse, briefcase, laptop computer, camera bag). The maximum permitted dimensions for the personal item are **15 x 11 x 3.9 inches**.
- Please limit the size of your carry-on or small bag to a small duffel, backpack or other soft-sided bag. Carry-on/small bag luggage needs to be something you could hold on your lap or place under your seat on the bus. The maximum size of your carry-on should be **21 x 15 x 9 inches**.
- **BUS STORAGE IS LIMITED; OVERHEAD BINS ARE VERY SMALL.**

Airline baggage rules differ from airline to airline. If you have questions, you should check with the airline on which you are booked for details.

Packing light:

You are encouraged to pack light for these reasons:

- **Less to carry:** You will be responsible for moving your luggage.
- **Peace of Mind:** Unfortunately, luggage can get lost or misdirected and not arrive at your destination when you do. You also risk that your luggage might arrive in less-than-ideal condition.
- **No overage fees:** Airlines charge hefty overage fees for bags over the 50-pound limit. Plan to weigh your bag before you travel to avoid these fees.
